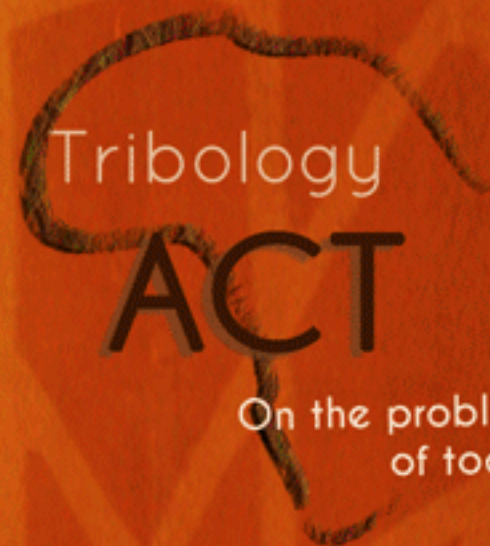

Objectives

The 1st African Conference in Tribology will be held at the Ecole Nationale des Sciences Appliquées (National School of Applied Science) of Marrakesh Morocco, April 27-30, 2014.
